**SUBJECT: Approval of Proposed Construction Contract for the renovation of the University of the District of Columbia David A. Clarke School of Law**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 38-1241.01, the University of the District of Columbia has the authority and responsibility to implement its capital procurement program; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 8B DCMR § 205, the Board of Trustees is required to approve all proposed contracts in excess of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) prior to the presentation of such contracts to the Council of the District of Columbia for its approval; and

**WHEREAS**, the administration has presented a proposed contract, as well as all necessary certifications from the administration; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has reviewed the terms of the contract, as well as all necessary certifications from the administration; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board is satisfied that the proposed contract represents the proper culmination of the University's procurement process and represents what is most advantageous to the University; and


