UDC Resolution 2012-23

SUBJECT: Conferral of Honorary Degree upon Carl Wieman, Associate Director of Science, White House Office of Science and Technology Policy

WHEREAS, pursuant to D.C. Code §38-1202.06(3), the Board of Trustees has authority to award degrees and to establish policy with respect to the award of degrees; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 8 DCMR §315.3, the Board of Trustees have approved the recommendation of Dr. Wieman by affirmative vote of at least three-fourths (¾) of the members present; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 8 DCMR §315.2, the President, upon consultation with the Faculty Senate, has recommended that Dr. Carl Wieman be awarded an honorary degree based on his achievements in science, including a Nobel Prize in Physics; his public service as a key science and technology advisor to the President of the U.S.; his contributions to science education in higher education, work for which he has been cited by the Carnegie Foundation and the National Science Foundation; and for being an exemplary teacher, for which he has won awards from the National Science Foundation and the American Association of Physics Teachers.


