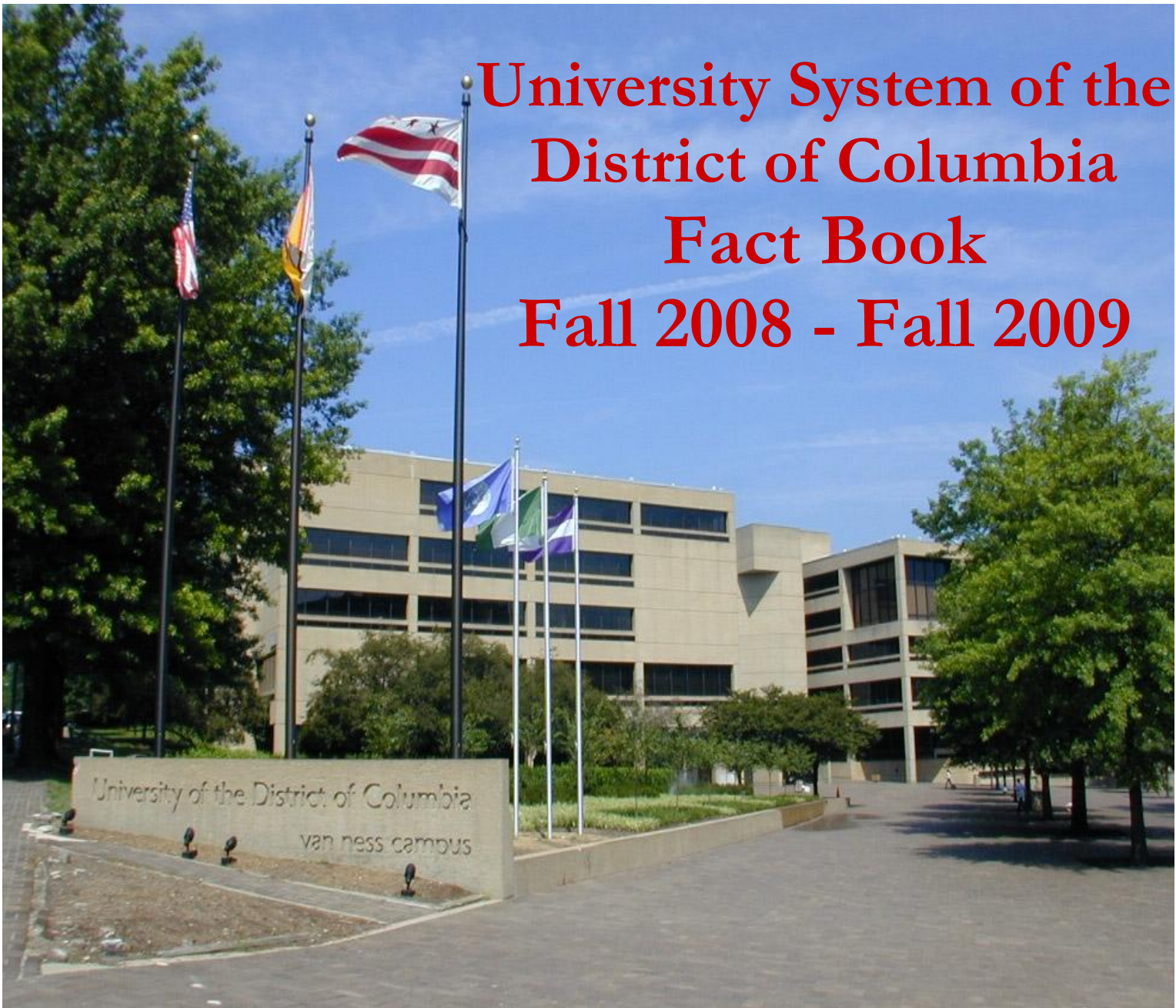

The information presented here was collected and organized by the Office of Institutional Research, Assessment and Planning. This office serves as the clearinghouse for official University statistics to promote consistency in reporting timely and accurate information. Most of the information provided was collected from official University reports generated by the Office of Information Technology, extracted from the University's database by the IRAP office, and the David A. Clarke School of Law Registrar.

This comparative Fact Book is the second of its kind and establishes benchmark data for the Fall 2009 semester of the University System of the District of Columbia. The System includes the newly established Community College of the District of Columbia and the Flagship University (baccalaureate programs, graduate programs, and the David A. Clark School of Law). The data contained herein represents official institutional records used for reporting to federal and local agencies, institutional planning and effectiveness, as well as our accreditation body.

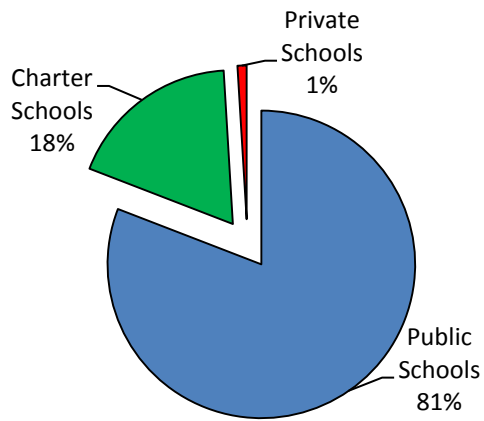

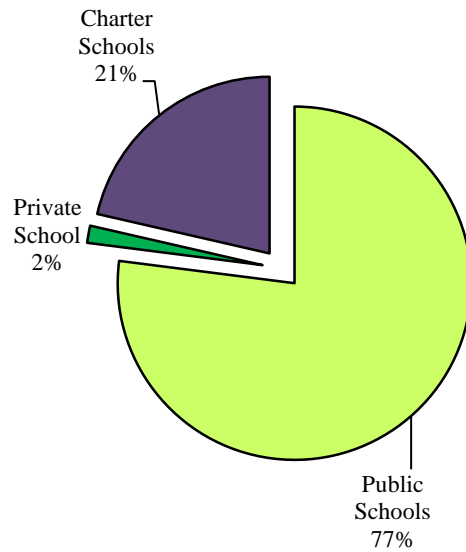

Fall 2009**



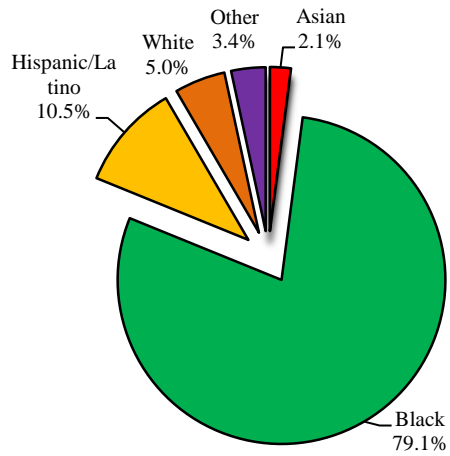

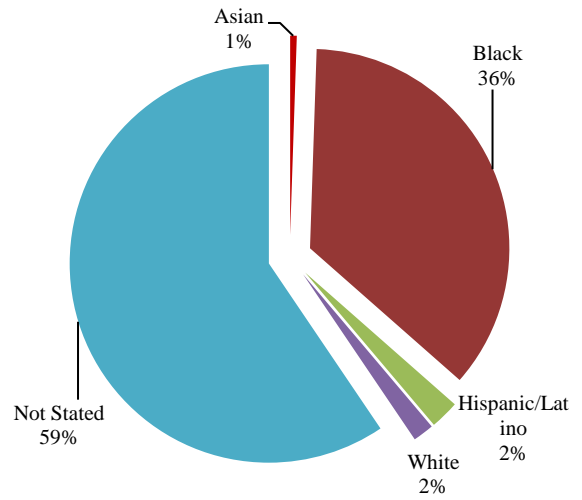

Figure 4 . Entering Freshmen Enrollment in the University System of the District of Columbia by Ethnicity Fall 2009



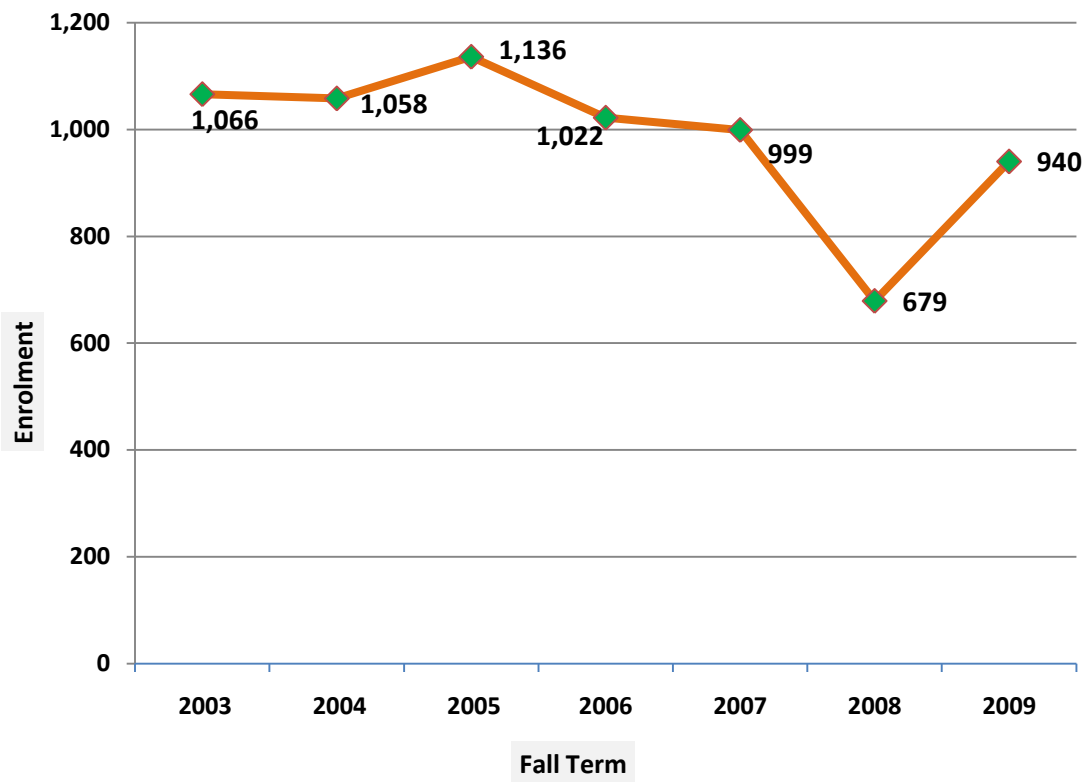

Figure 5 : Entering Freshmen Headcount Enrollment Trend: Fall 2003 - Fall 2009

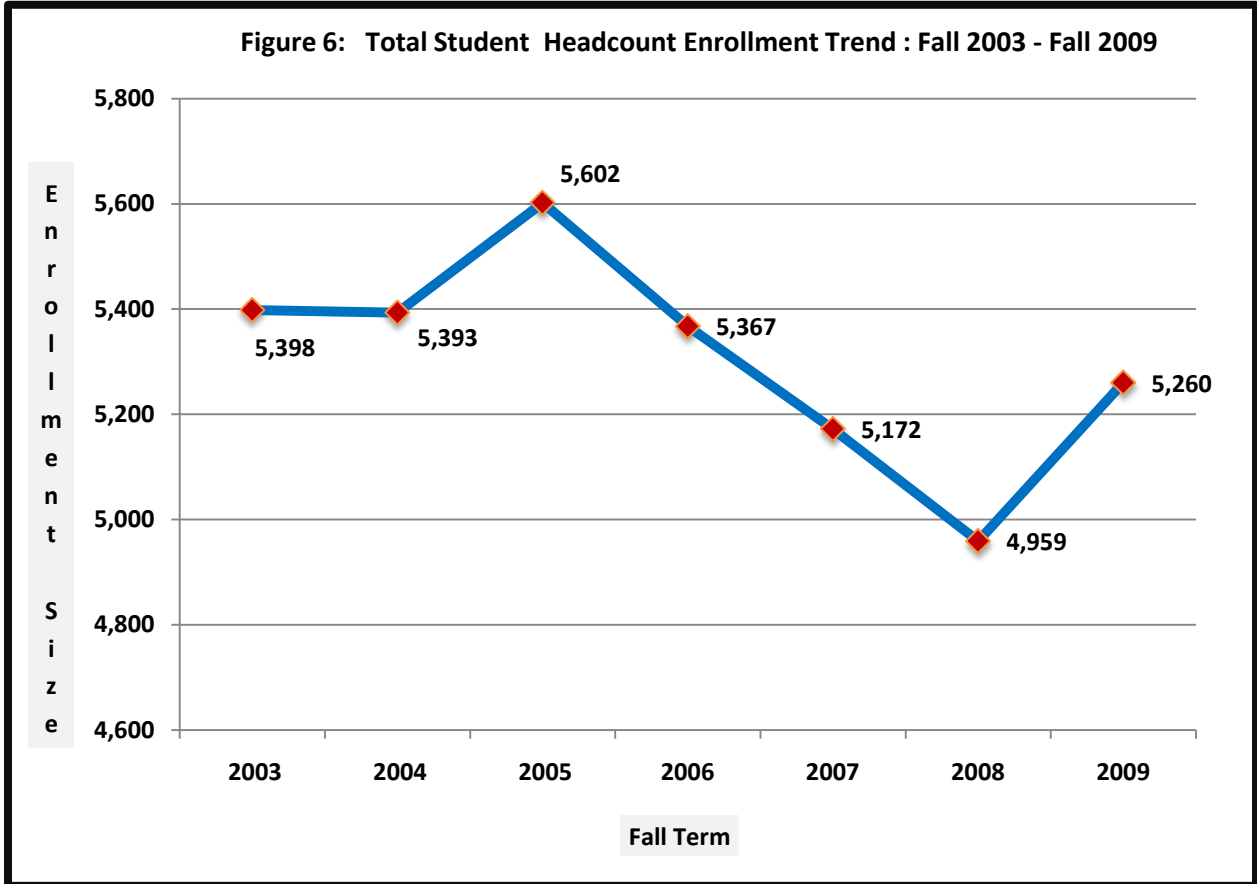

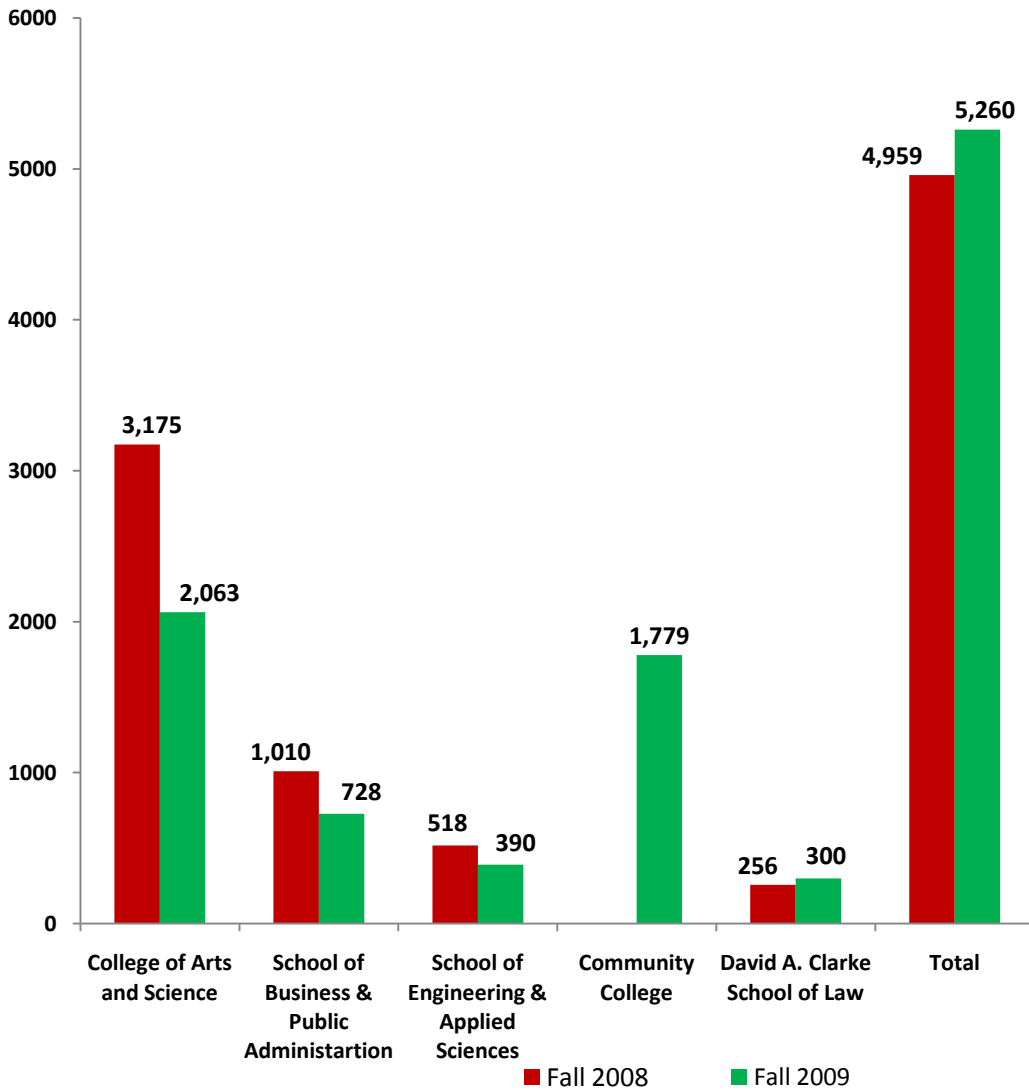

Figure 7. Total Enrollment by College/Schools: Fall 2008 - Fall 2009



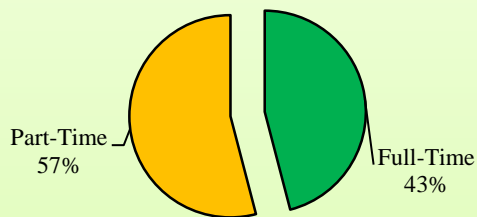

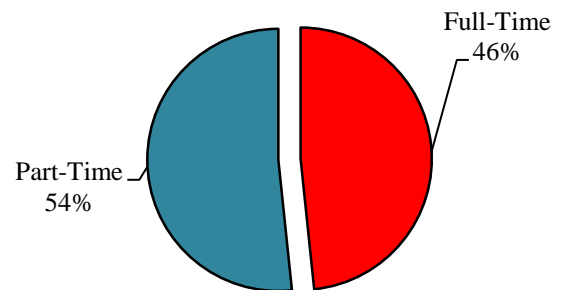

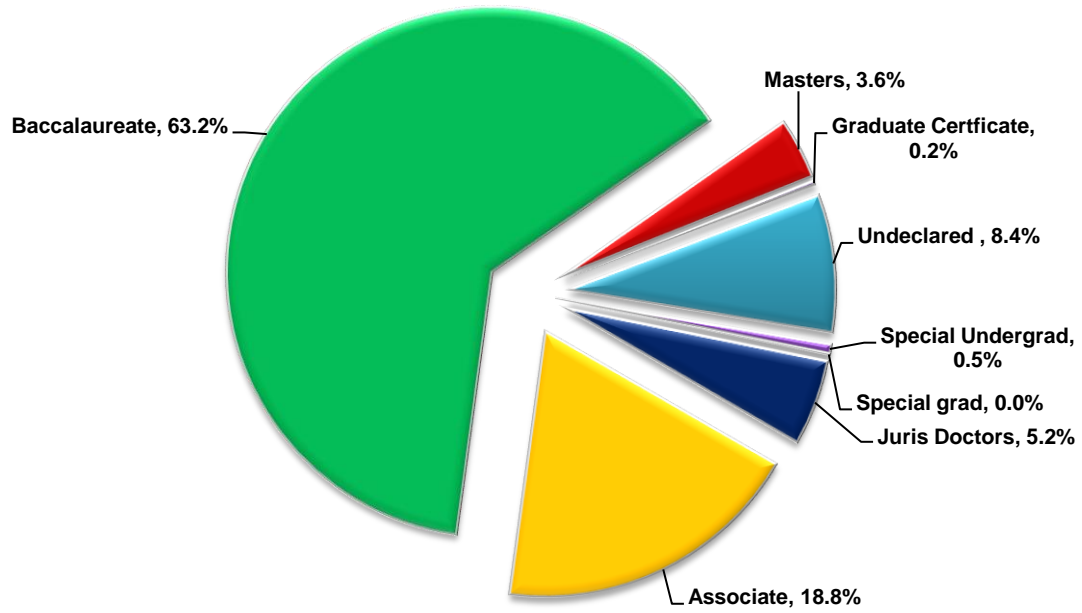

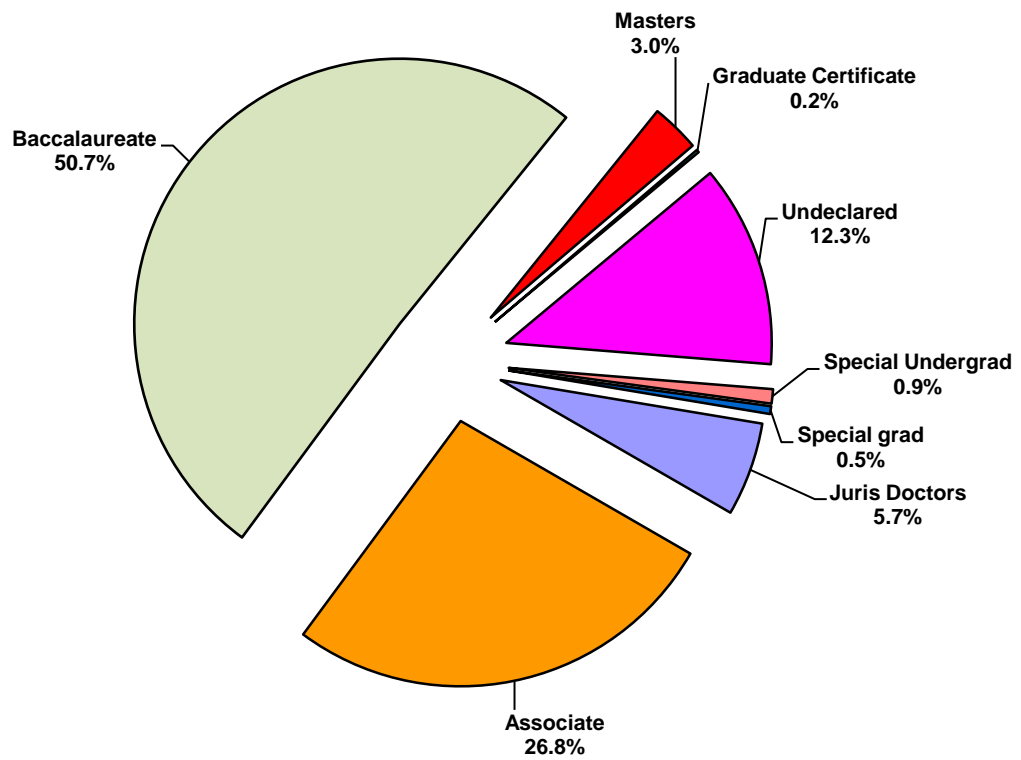

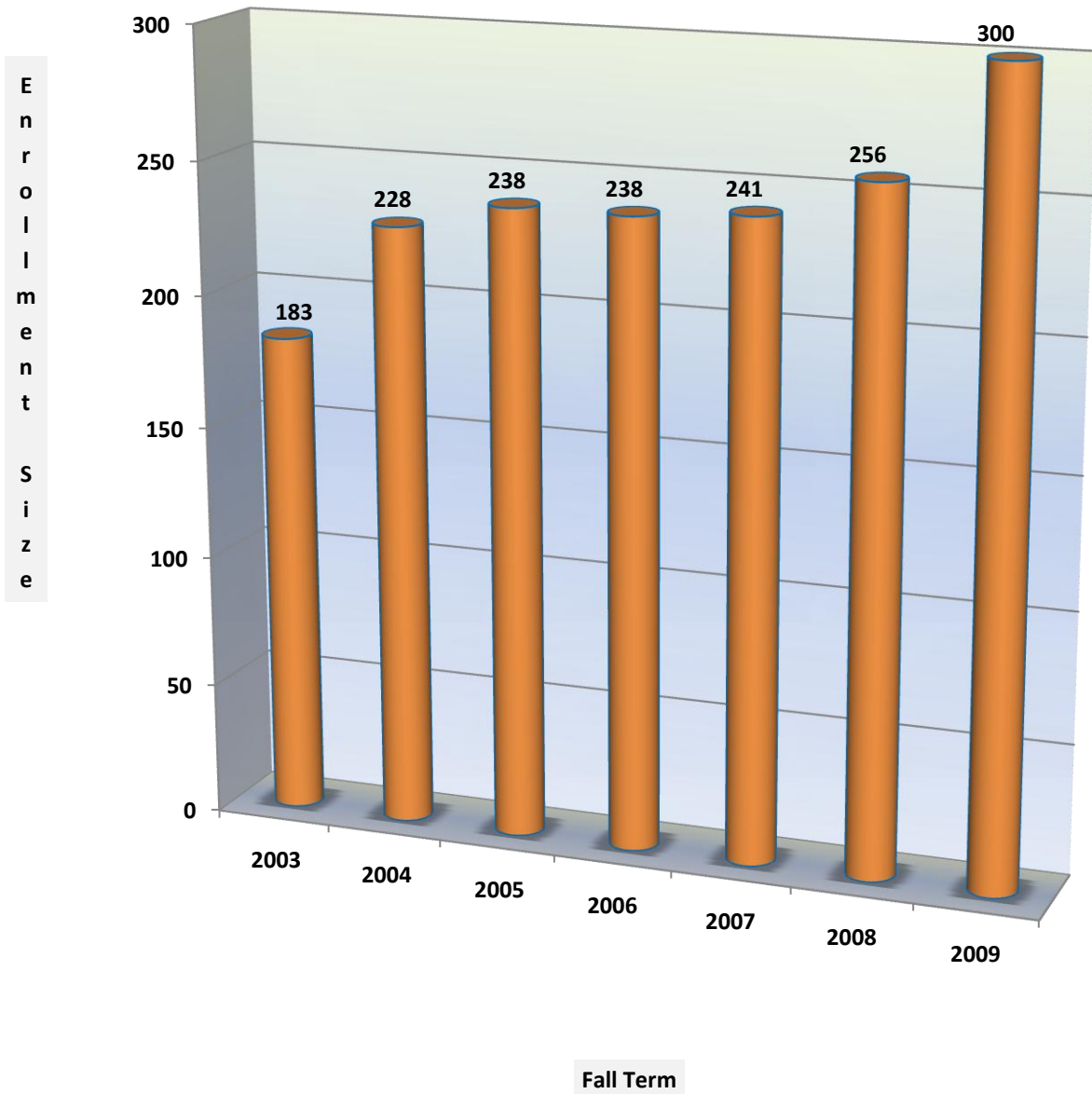

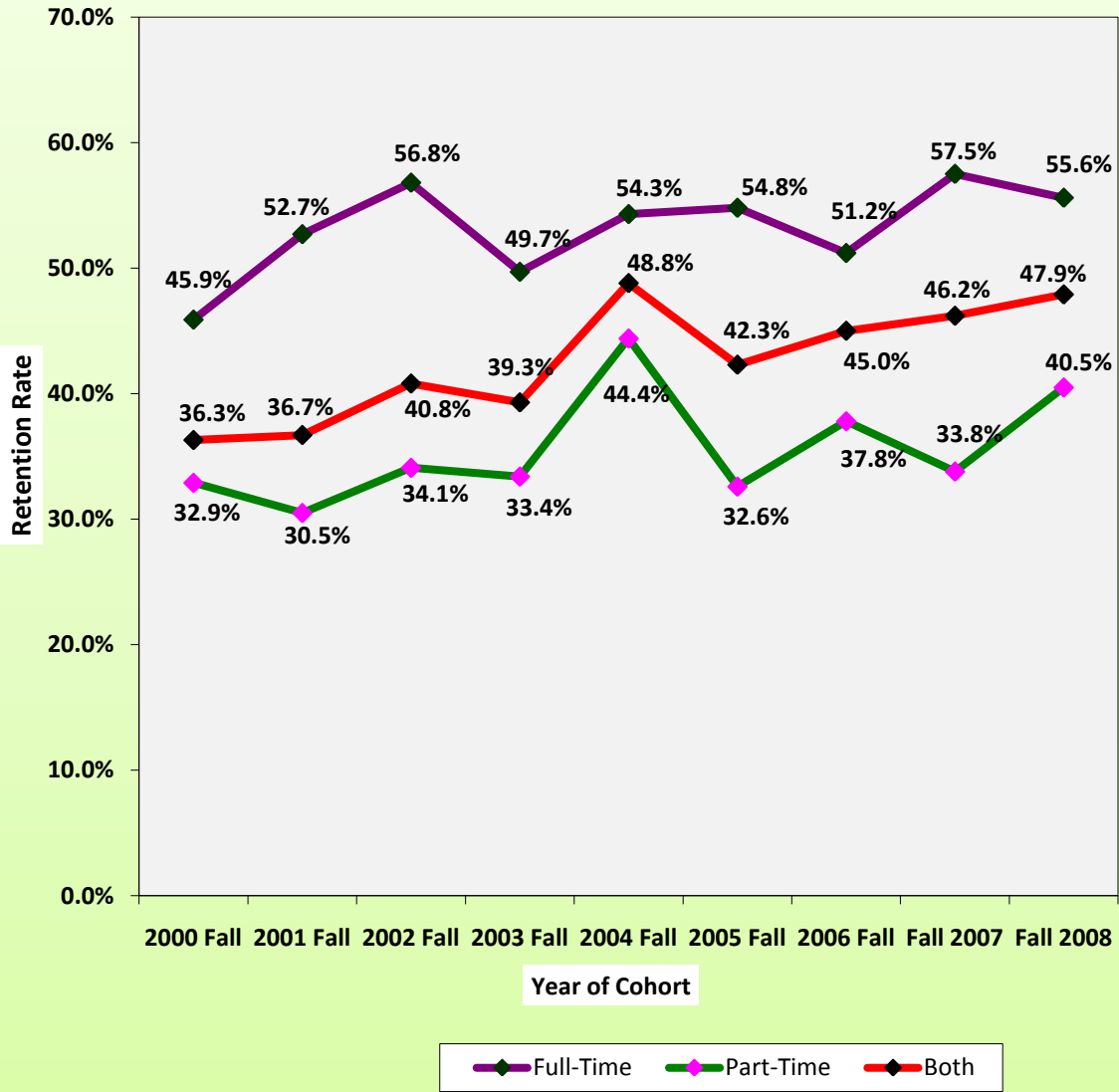

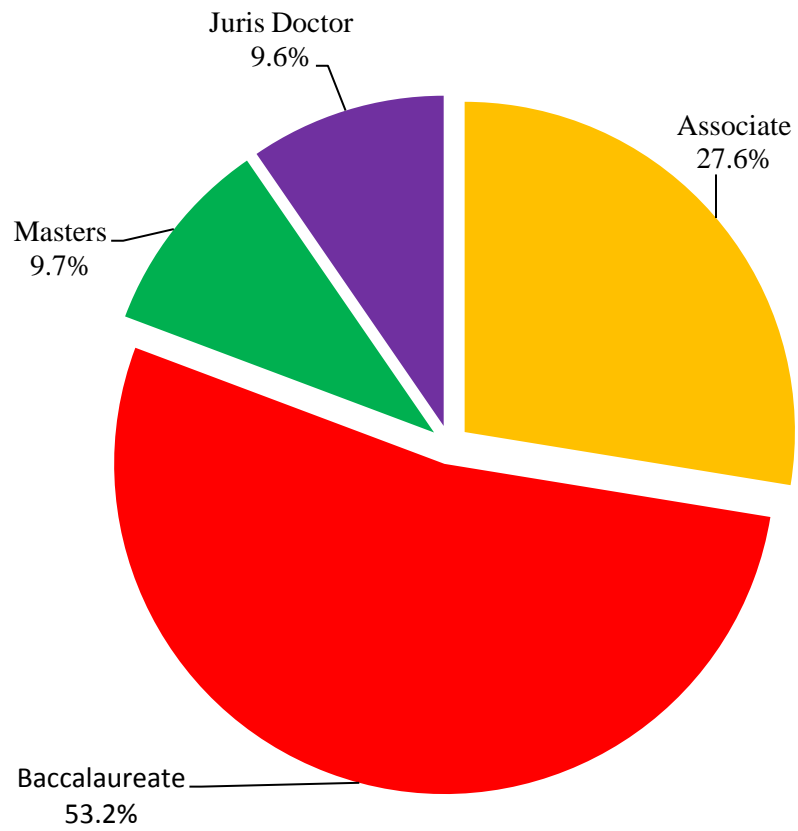

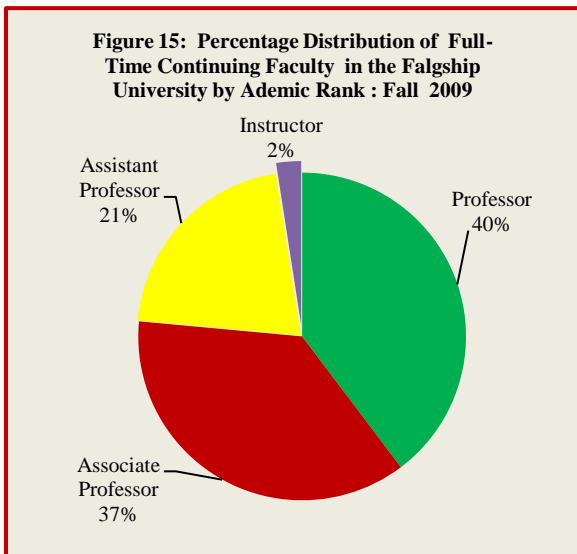

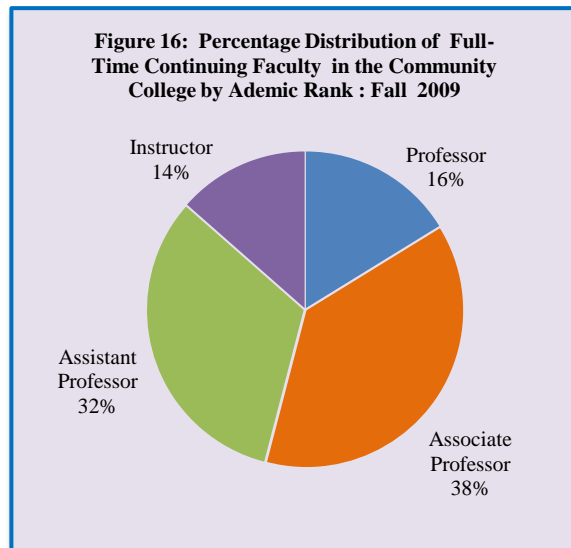

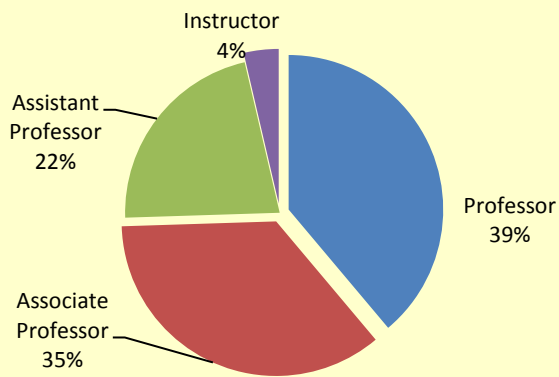

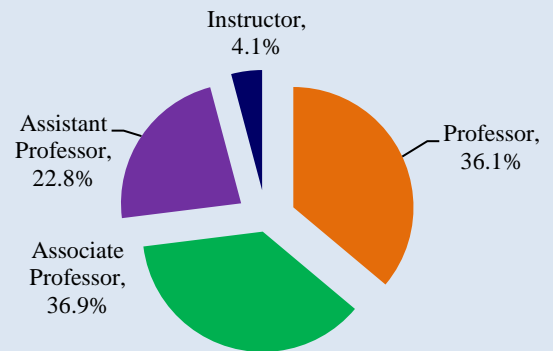

Figure 18 : Full-Time Continuing Faculty in the University System of the District of Columbia by Academic Rank: Fall 2009



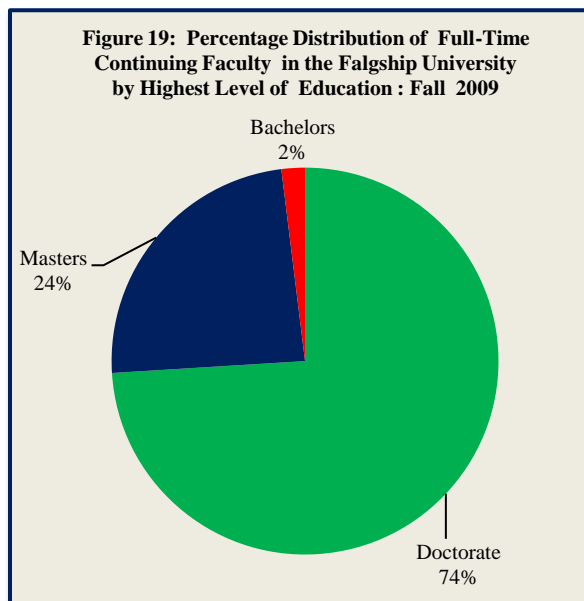

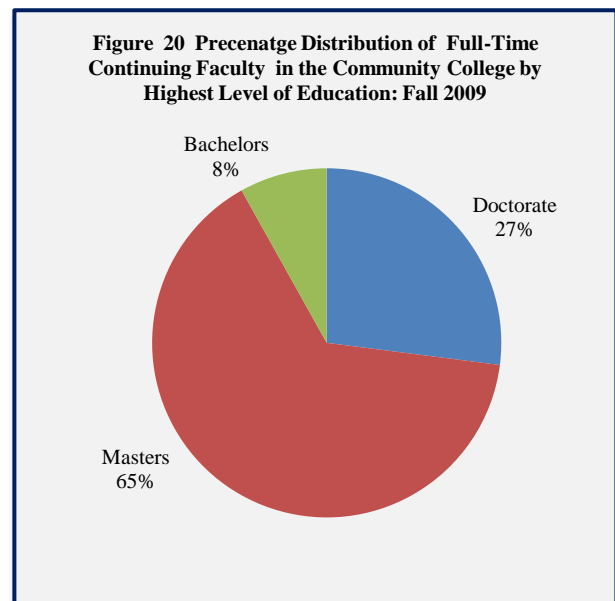

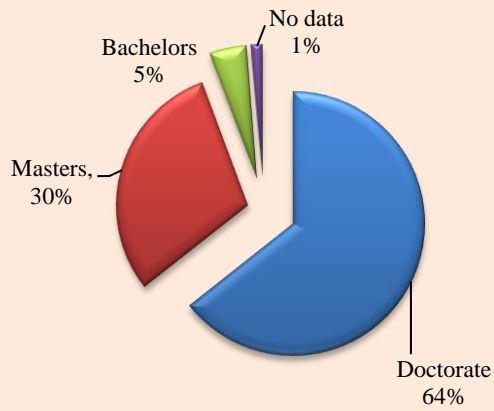

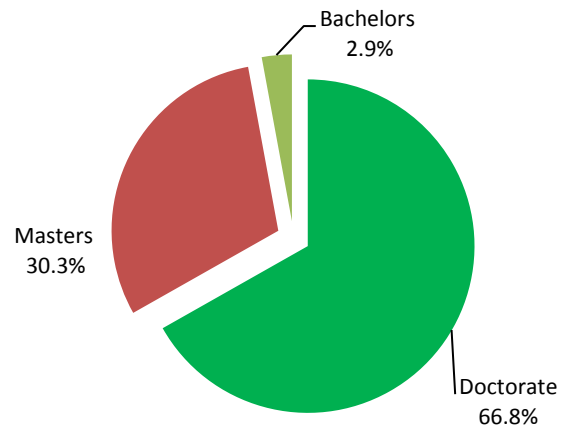

Figure 21 : Percentge Distribution of Full-Time Continuing Faculty at the University of the District of Columbia by Highest Level of Education: Fall 2008



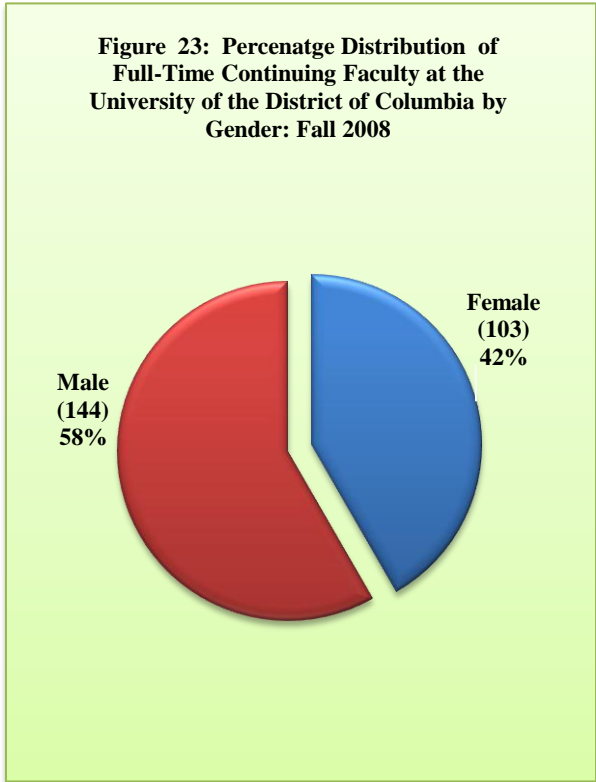

Figure 22: Percentge Distribution Full-Time Continuing Faculty in the University System of the District of Columbia by Highest Level of Education: Fall 2009



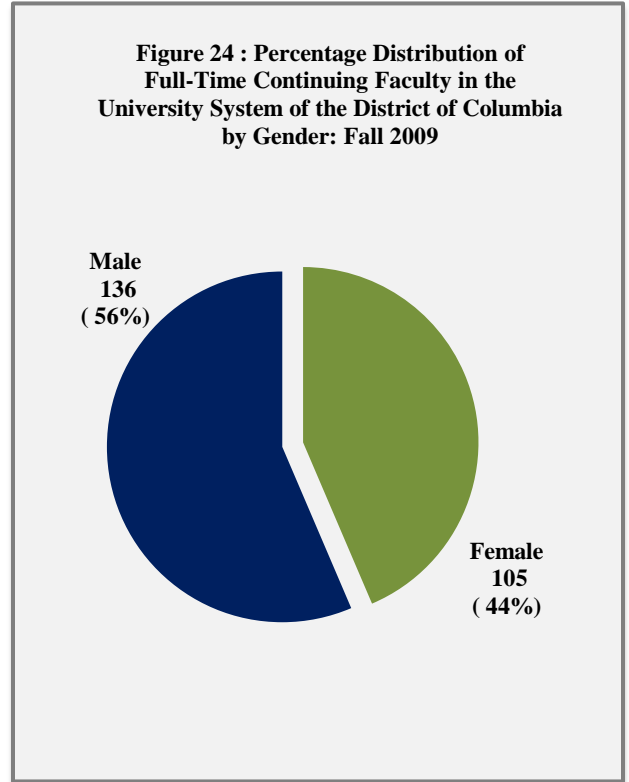

Figure 23: Percenatge Distribution of Full-Time Continuing Faculty at the University of the District of Columbia by Gender: Fall 2008



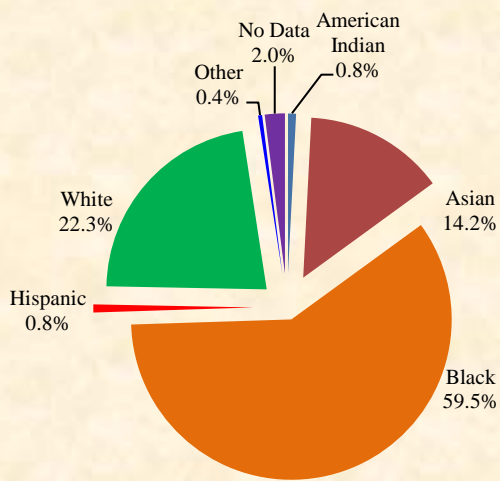

Figure 24 : Percentage Distribution of Full-Time Continuing Faculty in the University System of the District of Columbia by Gender: Fall 2009



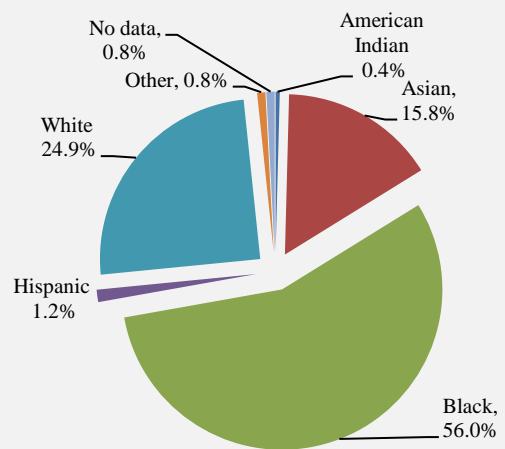

Figure 25: Percentage Distribution of Full-Time Continuing Faculty at the University of the District of Columbia by Ethnicity: Fall 2008



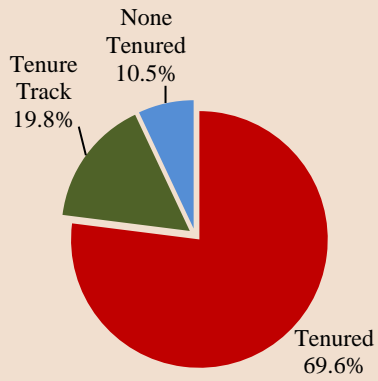

Figure 26: Percentage Distribution of Full-Time Continuing Faculty in the University System of the District of Columbia by Ethnicity: Fall 2009



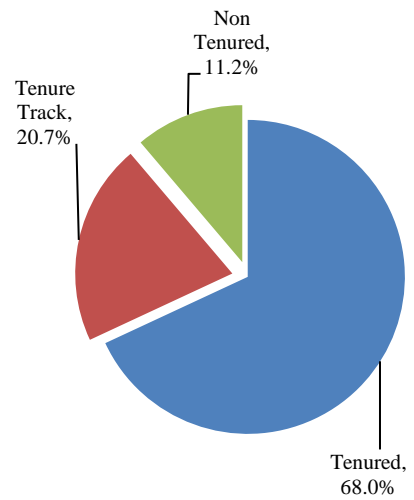
