- Must not owe "Outstanding Balance" for some scholarships (See respective scholarship requirements)
- Students applying for Merit/Honors Scholarships must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 (refer to specific GPA requirements for all other scholarships)
- Must be enrolled full-time or half-time (See respective scholarship requirements)
(Undergrad 12 F/T Min - 6 H/T Min Credit Hrs. - Graduate 9 F/T Min - 6 H/T Min Credit Hrs.)
- Must submit a 350-500 Word Essay with application (refer to scholarship announcements)
- Must submit two Letters of Recommendation with application
