

James Edward Miller Chapman Educational Foundation Scholarship (JEMC)

SPONSOR: University of the District of Columbia Foundation, Inc.

SCHOLARSHIP: The JEMC scholarship provides financial assistance for students enrolled in the business degree program at the University of the District of Columbia. Four (4) students are annually awarded a \$1,000 scholarship for one academic year, which may be applied to expenses for tuition, fees, and books only.

ELIGIBILITY: District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) graduate; incoming or continuing student, graduate or undergraduate level; resident of the District of Columbia for the duration of the scholarship award; a business major or a student who intends to pursue a business curriculum; meet and maintain a 2.75 grade point average.

Employees, officers of the University, or relatives thereof are not eligible for this award.

APPLICATION: An application, a typewritten double-spaced 500-word essay on “**Why did you Choose your Major,**” and two (2) letters of recommendation are required from persons other than family members who know the applicant well, e.g. a principal, teacher, counselor, or community leader.
