CRITERIA

Applicants for the Paul Phillips Cooke Scholarship

- Must be admitted to the Teacher Education Program at the University of the District of Columbia;
- Must be a resident of the District of Columbia;
- Must be available to pursue 12 or more credit hours per semester (undergraduate) or 6 or more credit hours per semester (graduate);
- Must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.8 or better (undergraduate) or 3.0 or better (graduate);
- Must submit a letter of support/recommendation from your academic advisor;
- Must submit an essay that focuses on the Department of Education's mission that is expressed in its theme - ***Renewing the Legacy of Excellence***. Explain how you can continue to embrace excellence in teaching by adhering to the tenets/components of this theme - ***Diversity, Transformation, Reflection, and Collaboration***.
