Submitted questions for Request For Proposal GF-2025-R-0019 for Network Resiliency Analysis Services, received as of May 2nd, 2025 at 2:00PM local time, are as follows:

#	Question	Response
1	C.10.1 states that no subcontracting or engagement of third-party services would be allowed or considered. Since the majority of the assessment services requested may be best delivered by Cisco Advanced Services, the clause appears to prevent this type of engagement. Please clarify if the submission by a Cisco Certified Partner providing a Cisco Advance Services engagement would be considered responsive.	The winning vendor should perform the work of the SOW directly themselves, to include project management, however they can interact with third parties as necessary to complete the work. We do not want the winning vendor to subcontract out sections/the entirety of the SOW to third parties, nor for the winning vendor to use subcontractors for project management. Engagement to Cisco Advanced Services or any other in place Manufacturers/Vendors/Service Providers will be done directly by the winning vendor and not subcontracted out to another party to engage Cisco Advanced Services and any other Manufacturers/Vendors/Service Providers.
2	We would like to see if it is possible to receive a 2 week extension on the Network Reliability Assessment Services RFP (Proposal NO. GF-2025-R-0019).	<p>We are not providing further extensions as we have already pushed our start date back and will be running up against limits with our implementation schedule with further delays.</p> <p>The University declines to extend the RFP, GF-2025-R-0019. The cutoff for proposal submission is 5/9/2025 at 2:00PM Local Time, as established by Amendment 001 (GF-2025-R-0019-001).</p>
