SUBJECT: UDC David A. Clarke School of Law Tuition Adjustments

WHEREAS, District of Columbia law (D.C. Official Code §1202.06(8)) provides for the Board of Trustees of the University of the District of Columbia to fix tuition, and fees in addition to tuition, to be paid by resident and nonresident students attending the University; provided, that such tuition and fees are adopted by the Trustees in accordance with the provisions of D.C. Official Code §2-505(a); and

WHEREAS, the University of the District of Columbia David A. Clarke School of Law has consistently been recognized as a premier law school and has been in growing demand among prospective students; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for School of Law tuition to be revised in keeping with overall revision of tuition and fee structures for all components of the University System of the District of Columbia during Academic Years 2009-2010 and 2010-2011; and

WHEREAS, the proposed revision represents an increase of approximately twenty percent (20%) over current tuition; and

WHEREAS, the proposed tuition rates are appropriate given the high quality legal education and rising demand for admission to the School of Law, while remaining affordable to all students, especially those seeking to continue in the law school's tradition of public service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the University of the District of Columbia hereby adopts the attached Notice of Proposed Rulemaking relating to the UDC David A. Clarke School of Law tuition rates; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the General Counsel is hereby directed to publish this Resolution and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the District of Columbia Register as soon as is practicable for a comment period of not less than thirty (30) days, in accordance with the provisions of D.C. Official Code § 2-505(a).
