SUBJECT: Approval of Master of Science in Electrical Engineering Program

WHEREAS, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 38-1202.06(3), the Board of Trustees is authorized to establish or approve policies and procedures governing admissions, curricula, programs, graduation, the awarding of degrees, and general policy for the components of the University; and

WHEREAS, the administration seeks to implement a graduate program leading to the degree of Master of Science in Electrical Engineering; and

WHEREAS, offering a graduate degree in electrical engineering will be responsive to high industry and student demand, and is projected to tap into a large pool of available grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the Master of Science in Electrical Engineering Program has been approved by all required levels of faculty and administration; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the University of the District of Columbia is hereby authorized to implement the Master of Science in Electrical Engineering program in accordance with the attached proposal; *provided that* the funds required to implement the program shall not be obligated until they have been identified and reprogrammed within existing University resources.
