## UDC RESOLUTION NO. 2009-04

SUBJECT: Structure of Community College Component of University System of the District of Columbia

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, pursuant to the provisions of D.C. Code §38-1202.06(16), has overall authority to govern the University of the District of Columbia, and, may, pursuant to D.C. Code §38-1202.06(3),establish or approve policies and procedures governing admissions, curricula, programs, graduation, the awarding of degrees, and general policy making for the components of the University;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, in UDC Resolution No. 2009-01, directs the President to establish within the University System of the District of Columbia a low-cost, open-admission Community College, focusing on workforce development, technical and academic certifications and academic associate degrees;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that in carrying out UDC Resolution 2009-01, the President shall be guided by the following provisions:

- The President of the University System shall appoint a Community College Campus Chief Executive Officer who shall manage the day-today operations of the Community College and shall serve at the pleasure of the President.
- 2. The President shall establish a separate name and marketing/public relations identity for the Community College which shall reflect its nature as a low-cost Community College option.
- 3. The President shall locate suitable facilities for the Community College.
- 4. The President shall determine the appropriate program offerings to effectuate the mission of the Community College.
- 5. The Board directs the President to establish a Community College with the following components/programs: technical and vocational training; workforce development; certificate programs; associate degree programs

which fully articulate to four-year programs at the flagship institution; and developmental education programs.
